## **Camp Themes & Descriptions**

### **Water Warriors (Entering 3rd-5th Grade)**

The ocean needs you! Campers will come together with like-minded peers and experience a week of ocean conservation during this classroom-based camp. Through exploration of Mote Aquarium and Mammal Center and Sarasota Bay, campers will learn about the threats our oceans face and what they can do to help. Campers will learn about youth programs and projects and be exposed to real citizen science projects. Not all heroes wear a cape!

### **Junior Ocean Technology Camp (Entering 3rd-5th Grade)**

Digitally “dive” into a week of exploration. Using technology and teamwork, campers will uncover ocean mysteries in this tech lab camp. Campers will create digital stories using stop motion, learn simple computer programming, and utilize toy robotics to explore the oceans just like our scientists.

### **ArtSea (Entering 3rd-5th Grade)**

What do science and art have in common? Everything! Campers will channel their inner artist while learning about the magnificent life under the sea in this classroom-based camp. Through hands-on activities and exploration, campers will create different marine masterpieces using a variety of mediums. Campers will learn how they can use art to tell a story of conservation and ocean protection. No previous art experience is necessary—this is a time to let your creativity shine!

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## **Ocean Technology Camp (Entering 6th-8th Grade)**

How do scientist explore the ocean? Using teamwork and digital detective skills, campers will explore the depths of the oceans. Based out of our tech lab, campers will use a combination of stop motion, storytelling, computer programming and fun robotics to become a scientist for the week. Digitally “dive” into a week of exploration with us! This year we have added an overnight component on Friday! Campers will get checked in for camp as normal on Friday and spend the night at Mote Aquarium. At check-out on Saturday, parents can view the campers showcase projects.
